



Jay Morris, the grower, owns vineyards in both the Petaluma Gap AVA, as well this vineyard west of the town of Sebastopol which can be denoted as Sonoma Coast or Green Valley AVA. As such, the fruit benefits from a very cool climate, leading to great acidity and a layered flavor profile. This vineyard is named after Jay's grandfather who was the first farmer in the family and is a name carried forth in the family line. While often a component of our WestLands Pinot Noir, we wanted to highlight this vineyard in this single vineyard bottling.

Fun Fact: This is our first vintage of Felix Hunter as a vineyard designate Pinot Noir.
